






Z-arts supports everyone who joins in on their creative journey through life.






Our mission

To inspire and enable generations of young people from across Manchester and beyond to use creativity to reach their potential.

"If I wasn't coming here and performing every month I'd be out on the streets and so would all the other people who come here. It's so rewarding."

Case study

Fiona Murray (Metropolitan Division, Greater Manchester Police) says

"A girl attended the Summer Fashion project and she was referred because of concerns for her anti-social behaviour and aggression. Her behaviour in and out of school was concerning the community and when examining her needs we found that this girl's home responsibilities were extremely demanding and reducing time that she could spend on herself.

"As a result of the summer fashion project this girl who now appears more like a young woman has excelled in confidence. She has clear ambitions about wanting to attend college next year, and has shown her fashion portfolio to her school. Both the school and the local police have been really impressed with her behaviour and increased selfesteem and we recognise that Z-arts provided a relevant opportunity at a key time in her life. As a result she is now engaging in further opportunities to develop herself." "He has become more talkative over the summer; usually he does not really talk to me that much, but every time he comes home from this place he is always telling me about what he has done and so we talk more about everything." Education

In 2011 Z-arts worked with over 50 schools, delivering 73 unique educational interventions, including Arts Week and Schools Linking Days where children have fun taking part in lots of different arts activities, sharing and learning together.

"Working with Z-arts has enhanced the pupils' work, impressed senior management in school and has had a positive impact on our pupils who don't get the chance to work with talented artists because of their social and behavioural issues."



Developing a young workforce

Z-arts are committed to reducing youth unemployment by offering training, volunteer schemes, work placements, apprenticeships and entry-level jobs.

"I think Z-arts gives a good opportunity for young people to come and socialise and meet new people; but, at the same time, it can help us to develop our different skills in a lot of different and positive ways."

Case study:

Nicola walked past Z-arts in 2009 and saw an advert for a day's workshop in technical theatre. Having nothing better to do that day, she came along. That started a journey that resulted in her being the pilot for a new Z-arts volunteer scheme, the first of 26 people who Z-arts put through the Future Jobs Fund programme (giving further employment opportunities to 30%), to a part-time employment contract. Nicola is now Z-arts fulltime Events Coordinator.

Artists making work

Z-arts loves developing partnerships with artists to give them space, resources and creative soundingboards to enable them to create new work.

Resident companies like Lip Service, Company Chameleon and Library Theatre Company make their shows here and then take the Z-arts name on tour.
