Case Study

We ran Explore Arts Award for 12 KS2 pupils from Bridgelea Primary school. Armed with 'arts expert kits' they worked with (an interviewed) a variety of artists from puppeteers to spoken word artists, recording their creative work in an arts log and creating an exhibition at Withington library. All children successfully achieved their Explore Arts Award.
