

Z-arts is directly opposite Hulme Park.

Entrance

When you enter Z-arts, you will see a sign, some plants, a fish tank and some steps. On your left, there is a ramp. If you go up the ramp or up the steps, you will get to our Box Office desk.

Box Office

This is what you will see as you climb the steps towards Box Office. When you arrive, the person at the desk with help you get to the show!





Z-café

If you look to your left when you're standing facing the Box Office desk, there is a corridor with lots of posters. This takes you through to Z-café.

You can buy food and drink from the counter at Z-café. There are plenty of options, including vegan, vegetarian and halal choices.

There are male and female toilets and an accessible toilet in Z-café. They are on the left when you are facing the counter.

There is a second entrance and exit door located in the café next to the toilets.






Take the stairs or lift, up to the Brayshaw room.


Take the stairs which are above the red double doors leading to Box Office.

When you reach the first landing, you'll see a set of red double doors (they're in the picture on this page). Go through these doors, take the stairs on your left and then turn right and go through the white door, directly in front of you.

A Z-arts staff member will direct you to the theatre when the show is about to begin!

If you need to take the lift, ask one of our stewards. There are two lifts you can take and the steward will take you to the most convenient one.





The Brayshaw Gallery

This is where the magic happens!

You will be able to find lots of aliens, zombies, monsters and other characters in the Box Office and café areas and you can follow them like a trail, up to the Brayshaw room where the main exhibition is.

All of the characters are cardboard and are around 4 to 5 foot tall. There will be gentle atmospheric audio playing.



How long is the event?

The Hunt is up to an hour long and the workshops are 2 hours each.



What to Expect

You can do the Hunt, in which you have to find characters which are in the Box Office and café areas.

You can also visit the main exhibition for up to an hour.

If you've booked into a workshop, these will be lead by Aaron, the artist and he will show you how he creates his characters and you will get the chance to draw your own.

You don't need to know how to draw. This is a workshop for all abilities.

You will also get the chance to get Aaron to draw you a special unique character.
