











What to expect when you visit the exhibition:

Creative Workshops



To make your experience here even more magical we suggest taking part in a workshop with us! Especially if you'd like to bring more than one class!

Our creative workshops support literacy through playful interactive drama & storytelling. Each workshop is one hour long and delivered by an experienced arts educator and is designed to incorporate "speaking, moving & creating" elements within it. The children will work on their confidence and speaking & listening skills in a playful fun way that will harbor a love of stories! All sessions can be adapted to cater to disabled, SEN, and EAL children.

We differentiate the workshops for EYFS, KS1 & KS2 to grapple with characterisation and themes within the stories relevant to their capacity.

EYFS - Billy Goats Gruff, Trip Trap Trip What?

Using characterisation, poetry, and movement we will explore how to be clever and persuasive in our storytelling.

KS1 - Little Red Riding Hood - Good, bad, or misunderstood?

How can we address baddies & villains? How do we stand up to bully's and take action? In this workshop, we will look at the concept of villains and how we tell stories through movement and our voices while discussing broader themes of antibullying & kindness.

KS2 - Cinderella - Cinderella liberator, let's put a spin on traditional concepts of princesses & princes!

In this workshop, we will celebrate heroes and heroines in stories and look at how we can make them more representative of us and relevant to us in a modern equal culturally diverse society.

Each child taking part in a creative workshop will receive a specially designed Fairy Tale Z-arts activity booklet, which has fun activities to fill out in the creative workshop AND is jam-packed with creative follow-up activities to take back to school with you!

You will have a Z-arts person ready to show you about the building and we have a fabulous space to host you for lunch with a brand-new adjacent toilet block.
