What to expect -

Who are the characters?

We'll meet Dommy B. This is a solo show in which Dommy B speaks about his Mum and three friends, Lotti, Jo, and Coralie.



This is Domonic Berry who plays Dommy B.

The show is just under an hour long.

There are lots of funny bits and chances for those to join in to join in, so it feels much shorter than it is as the time flies!



During the show -

You might feel happy. There are lots of jokes and funny bits!



Dommy B mentions not having a father living with him and briefly mentions how this sometimes made him sad and sometimes angry.

Sometimes Dommy B might ask you to join in!

This is voluntary - it's totally up to you.

People can participate, but no one has to participate.

There are many chances to do so, but just sitting and listening is cool too!

Are there loud noises?

Dommy B is a spoken word artist. Sometimes the story is told with an excited voice. Often it is told quietly. There are no recorded noises or sound effects.

No flashing lights and the lighting is soft.

Themes -

Gratitude for the fun and kind people we have in our lives, even if some other people - in Dommy B's case his father and the lads who tease him at school - are not doing what we might like them to be doing.

Dommy B speaks of and celebrates a diversity of many different family types - families can look very different in structure (foster families, single parent families, grandparents raising children) - and they can all be awesome!
