We've also enjoyed several Z-arts events, including the Les Enfants Terrible Show, the Escape Room, World Inside a Book, Fairy Tales, 100-Storey Hotel, and Haphazard.

The drama sessions with Tabitha have been a highlight for both children. They are excited about being part of the Bright Sparks Showcase performance, and the experience of rehearsing and performing in a real theatre has been new and thrilling for them. We've seen significant growth in their confidence, willingness to try new things, and ability to navigate the Z-arts space independently. Drama has become a cherished hobby for both, and we hope it continues to be part of their lives.

Joseph's participation in the drama class is a significant achievement. Historically, he has been reluctant to join new clubs, often dropping out quickly. However, the welcoming environment created by Tabitha has changed this pattern. Each week, Joseph looks forward to the drama sessions and is now even considering joining the Musical Theatre class, which would have been unthinkable before. Drama at Z-arts has broken his default behavior of quitting activities, and he genuinely enjoys the games and interactions.

Z-arts provides our family with a wonderful opportunity to spend Saturday mornings together, away from screens and engaged with peers and staff in a positive setting. The accessibility of the classes, the welcoming staff, the lack of uniform requirements, and the absence of pressure make Z-arts a unique and treasured space. The creative and beautiful environment allows our children to explore their interests freely. As parents, we love watching them enjoy themselves while we relax with a coffee. The beautiful library is an added bonus.

Money is tight, and the arts are becoming less accessible for families, but Z-arts remains a gem. It allows our children to discover and engage with drama and theatre in ways that would otherwise be out of reach. Without Z-arts, theatre tickets for a family of four would be beyond our budget, and managing clubs in different locations on Saturday mornings would require significant sacrifices.

Special Moments

One memorable moment was when Joseph came out of his first drama lesson and immediately asked to book the next session. The World Inside a Book was our first experience at Z-arts, and the magical moving bookcase captivated Joseph. He also had a fantastic 10th birthday party in the Escape Room, and we all enjoyed the Les Enfants Terrible show and the 100-Storey Hotel. Joseph's excitement after a drama rehearsal in the theatre, especially his joy at going backstage, was particularly meaningful.

Community Benefit

Z-arts feels almost too good to be true. It makes the arts accessible to everyone, regardless of cost, special needs, or academic abilities, opening up new worlds for children. It provides a safe place for young people to grow and learn new skills. The beautiful library, where families can read or attend intimate Q&A sessions with award-winning authors, adds immense value.
