Who are the characters?

About the Show





- Joy and celebration.




Who's the show for?

Recommended for ages 5+.

Perfect for families, children and adults.

This show is ideal for those with no previous experience of dance theatre.



What you will see & hear?

The solo performer brings the story to life through expressive, physical movement.

Animated projections that interact with the dancer.

An atmospheric soundtrack and spectacular lighting design.

There is no spoken dialogue, but the story is easy to follow through movement, visuals and emotion.



Audience Interaction

Towards the end of the performance, there's a moment that invites the audience to engage with the magical world created in the show. Participation is totally optional.

Sensory Information

The show includes music, atmospheric lighting and projections. There's no strobe lighting. Sound levels are designed to be comfortable for young audiences.
