Use the square outline below to create your own paper snow flake:

1. Use Cut along the BLUE arrow to create a square

2. Fold the square into triangles along the PURPLE dotted lines, folding the square in half, and then into quarters.

3. Next fold along the PINK dotted lines to create a small folded triangle.

4. Now use scissors to cut shapes out of the the edges of the triangle. Usually small triangle shapes work best, but you can try any shapes you like!

5. Once you are finished, unfold the paper carefully to reveal your snowflake!
