





# Developing Young Musicians Programme, with Arun Ghosh (16+)

### Background

In partnership with One Manchester and PRSF, Z-arts are developing a young musicians programme in collaboration with Arun Ghosh. Arun is jazz composer and clarinet player renowned for infusing his work with elements characteristic of traditional Indian music, jazz and world music. He performs with a band whose melodies and rhythms draw together jazz, hip-hop and South Asian music, with double-bass and the dazzling, percussive sounds of the tablah. With vast and diverse experience in instrumentation and production Arun will be an exciting mentor for those looking to step into the creative music industry.

Once a week, 12 developing musicians aged 16 + will work with a musician along with benefitting from being mentored monthly and performing in collaboration with Arun himself at Z-arts. The project will end  $7^{TH}$  March 2019.

The programme will include:

- Weekly sessions with a range of musicians in our Levi's Music Lab
- Monthly mentoring with Arun
- Live gigs with Arun

# **Young Person Specification**

We strongly welcome applications from young people who are in the early stages of creating and writing music, up to emerging artists attempting to bring their work into the public arena or gain experience in live music performance.

You might:

- Be learning an instrument or already play an instrument
- Be part of a school choir or music group
- Be studying music at college or university
- Have your own band or music group
- Use audio and music production software and equipment
- Have a bedroom studio set up or do busking

These are just some possibilities. Unfortunately this programme is not for regularly paid or signed musicians.
