







USE THESE STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE YOUR 'FAMILY FAIRYTALE COAT OF ARMS'





- Once you have your objects decide as a family which ones you can draw (each pick one item or more). Then lay out 4 pieces of paper to make a big portrait rectangle. There will be one picture on each piece of paper.
- Next you will need to draw a semi circle at the top of the top sheets, and slightly curved diagonal lines on the bottom two sheets (like the picture below). It will be best to draw these with the paper next to each other so all the edges line up, maybe in pencil first! Now draw your objects or symbols in each section.



- You can see below that I have drawn music notes instead of a vinyl record, I have also drawn my own copy of the instrument from my picture for the other section. Use your imaginations and maybe take colours and patterns from the objects too!



Now pick your colouring pencils, pens or paints to finish your design. Choose a colour scheme so the coat of arms is uniform. Stick your 4 pieces together at the back with tape, cut it out and stick it in the window for all to see!
